Throughout history, people of different cultures have built tombs as special places to bury their leaders such as kings and queens. One of the most prominent tombs ever built is the Taj Mahal in Agra, India. It is known as one ⁽¹⁾ of the largest and the most beautiful tombs ever constructed. Many people wonder why such an incredible building was ever created. It was built as a showpiece of architecture for the people of India to visit and enjoy, and it also ⁽²⁾ symbolizes one man's eternal love for his wife.

Mumtaz Mahal, the Emperor Shah Jahan's second wife, regularly traveled with her husband on official trips throughout India and abroad. She was a deeply beloved and trusted partner of the emperor. During that period in history, it was extremely rare for emperors to travel with their wives. For this reason, she was admired by millions of women in India. The emperor ordered the huge tomb to be built in memory of his favorite wife, Mumtaz Mahal, who died in 1631.

What makes the Taj Mahal so special is the amount of time and labor it required. Construction started in the early part of 1632 and was completed in 1648. More than 20,000 workers were used to complete the project. The walls were decorated with Arabic writing and precious stones collected from all over ⁽³⁾ the world. The symmetric white building blends perfectly into its surroundings. Moreover, there are few buildings that are able to rival the Taj Mahal's amazing and timeless elegance. It remains one of the finest examples ⁽⁴⁾ of Islamic architecture.

Unfortunately, Emperor Shah Jahan spent the last eight years of his life in

prison. He was put there by his son who defeated him to become the new Emperor of India. ^(a)Shah Jahan's only view of the Taj Mahal was through a tiny window in his prison cell. After his death, his body was also placed inside the tomb with his beloved wife. This year, the Taj Mahal is celebrating its 375th anniversary. More than eight million visitors annually come to see the Taj Mahal's breathtaking beauty. Nearly 15% of the visitors are from overseas. ⁽⁵⁾For the people of India, the love story hidden inside the Taj Mahal's walls is still a proud and lasting memory.
