

COMMUNIQUE


On behalf of Bunka Gakuen University and École nationale supérieure des Arts Décoratifs, Sunao Onuma, President of Bunka, and Marc Partouche, Dean of Ensad, are pleased to launch the partnership between their two institutions and announce the signature of the Mutual Agreement on the Double Degree Program.

The purpose of this newly signed document is to record the mutual agreement on a double degree program between Bunka Gakuen University, located in Tokyo, Japan and École nationale supérieure des Arts Décoratifs, located in Paris, France.

This program will involve Bunka's master's degree students in Global Fashion Concentration who would like to construct a collection as their graduation project and Ensad's fourth and fifth year students in Texture and Textile Design, and Fashion Design. They will spend their first year of the program at Bunka and the second year at Ensad and will participate in the latter's graduation fashion show. English will be the language of instruction at both institutions.
