## The man who kidnapped a show model and his real face

On Monday, September 4th, 1895,  
it was announced that a show model  
had been kidnapped by a vampire.

The incident took place at the Royal Albert Hall, during a fashion show to present the new Art Nouveau style. The unprecedented emergency situation turned the bright atmosphere into a tragedy, with screams flying everywhere. A vampire appeared backstage, and the models, who had just finished walking the runway, screamed and ran for cover. Finally, the main culprit, the vampire, appeared on stage. The models are too scared to run away. Anne Lalioue, a designer and eyewitness to the incident, said, "it sounded like he disappeared with a breeze." The vampires seemed to be gone like the wind. There was no time

to intervene. It was nothing short of shocking that the show had come to such a bad end. ### *Cutting-edge Art Nouveau Presented at Crime Scene*

-Art Nouveau style dresses were being showcased in a fashion show at the Royal Albert Hall, where a kidnapping took place. Characteristic in their curves and plant motifs, the designs were full of the joyous sense of the late 19th century. This, so called Art Nouveau style gained momentum with the Paris Exposition of 1900, and its presentation at the Royal Albert Hall, a kidnap scene in 1895, was well ahead of its time. The Parisian haute couturiers exhibited their works for the first time at the Exposition including Walt, Jeanne Pacquin, Callot Soeurs, with works of masquerade and historical costumes. By the time, Vogue and Harper's Bazaar were already published to report on the haute couture movement. And both magazines, which continue to this day, have become valuable sources of fashion history.

The name of the vampire, Count Dracula, is a name of a clan. He is a vampire who does not kill humans. He does not kill humans, but he does kill "humans" with different meanings. The hunters of the British Empire thought it was an odd something fishy about it. "If our friends we would stay in the forest, we imagine that there were more unusual than our quarry." Beardsley, a researcher on the subject, said "Vampires were supposed to have appeared in the Middle Ages after the war, according to various theories. But that is not our ancestors' view of vampires.
